



Vancouver Farmers Markets BC Berry Pie Bake Off !

Do you love to bake? Residents from all neighborhoods are invited to bake their favorite berry pie and enter it in our BC Berry Pie Bake Off on July 17. Open to amateur and professional bakers of all ages, the entry deadline is Wednesday, July 13th.

RESTRICTIONS Pre-registration is required. All pies must be named (make up your own name) and made with BC grown berries. Pies must be baked from scratch only and baked in a disposable pan marked on the bottom with your: **NAME, CONTACT INFORMATION AND PIE NAME.**

ENTRY DETAILS One pie per application - the same entrant can enter multiple pies. Must include one copy of your recipe (be sure your name does not appear on the recipe). Bring your pie(s) to the Contest Tent at Mt Pleasant Farmers Market (Guelph & 8th Ave) between 11:15 and 11:45 pm on Sunday, July 17. Due to time constraints, the contest is limited to 15 entries.

JUDGES Our judges will not know whose pie they are tasting. Pies will be judged based on the following: 50% Taste, 25% Appearance, 25% Originality/Creativity.

AWARDS

1st Place Winner will receive: \$25 in Market Money and a limited edition canvas VFM Shopping Bag
2nd Place Winner will receive: \$15 in Market Money and a limited edition canvas VFM Shopping Bag
3rd Place Winner will receive: \$10 in Market Money and a limited edition canvas VFM Shopping Bag

Winners of the 1ST, 2ND and 3RD Prizes will have his/her recipe published in the Farmers Market Newsletter and on the eatlocal.org website.
